1. Submit a Completed Application.
2. Be a member in good standing of the Rhode Island Branch of the Massachusetts and Rhode Island Chapter of Appraisal Institute
3. Be current with national and chapter dues and be current with Standards and Ethics course requirements for the Appraisal Institute

Application Process

In addition to this form, the application must include:

1. A brief (500 words or less) essay stating why the applicant should be awarded the scholarship. This essay can highlight such factors as professional goals and experience, financial need, involvement with the Rhode Island Branch, commitment to achieving a designation, etc.
2. A list of Appraisal Institute courses taken to date
3. A resume or statement of qualifications (including current appraisal licenses held)
4. All necessary receipts/transcripts to show proof of attending/passing the course
5. Submit a letter of recommendation
6. Other documentation to support application

Applications will be reviewed on demand. The Rhode Island Branch of the Massachusetts and Rhode Island Chapter will determine recipients based on funding available and the applications received.
